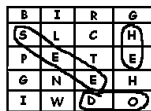


# Sight Word Activities

## Sight Word Search

Using [Puzzlemaker.com](http://Puzzlemaker.com) or any other internet puzzle making program - make a word search with targeted sight words and instantly your student can have fun finding their words!



## Spin a Sight Word

Targeted sight words are written on a spinner. A player spins the spinner and reads the word. If it is read correctly, they get a point. If sight word is read incorrectly--no points are earned. Player with the most points wins.

A reward could be given for a certain number of points if desired.



## Sight Word Magic Hat

Student writes targeted sight words on rabbits. They are placed in a hat. The student chooses a rabbit out of the hat and says the sight word. If they say the word correctly, they get to keep the rabbit. If word is read incorrectly, it is returned to the hat. Points could be given for each rabbit obtained and a reward given for a certain number of points if desired.



## Sight Word Tic-Tac-Toe

Target sight words are written on a tic-tac-toe card. When a player places an X or an O on a space, they must say the sight word correctly. If they say it incorrectly they do not get to put their X or O down. First player to get three words read correctly in a row (3 X's or 3 O's) is the winner.



## Sight Word Bingo

Targeted sight words are written on a bingo card. Parent calls out sight word and student must find word and put a marker on it. They get a bingo if they get 5 markers in a row and can read all 5 sight words in a row correctly.



## Sight Word Flashcards

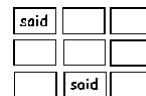
Targeted sight words are written on cards or use cards sent home with homework. Then they are quickly flashed in front of student. They earn a point for every sight word they get correct and a reward could be given for a certain number of points if desired.

## Sight Word Hide and Seek

Target sight words are hidden round a room in the house. Once student finds all the sight words, they then must read each one correctly. They earn a point for every sight word they get correct and a reward could be given for a certain number of points if desired.

## Sight Word Concentration

Place 2 of each targeted sight word cards on the floor. First player turns a card over and says the word, then they turn another card over and say the word. If the two word cards match and the player says the word correctly both times, they get to keep the matching pair. Then the next player repeats the same. Player with the most matching word pairs is the winner.



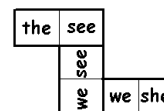
## Roll a Sight Word

Target sight words are written on a wood or paper cube. Players must say the sight word they roll correctly to earn points. If they say it incorrectly, no points are earned. Player with the most points wins. A reward could be given for a certain number of points if desired.



## Sight Word Dominoes

Two sight words are written on a paper domino. On the second card, two sight words are written, one of the words must match one of the words on the first card. Repeat this until all sight words have been written at least 3 times. Student must place sight word domino next to its word match and say the word matched correctly. Points could be given for each match and a reward given for a certain number of matches if desired.



## Sight Word Fishing

Student writes targeted sight words on pictures of fish. Paper clips are put on each fish. Using a stick with a magnet on the end, student fishes for sight words. Once they get a fish, they must say the word correctly in order to keep the fish. If it they say it incorrectly it is put back in the pile. Points could be given for each fish obtained and a reward given for a certain number of points if desired.



## Sight Word Checkers

The game is played just like checkers, except that in order for a player to get the checker they have successfully jumped over, they must correctly say all three words that were involved in the jump.



## Sight Word Go Fish

Using pairs of sight word cards, pass out 5 targeted sight word cards to each player. Remaining cards go in the middle of the table. Game is played just like "Go Fish" except that in order to keep a matching pair of cards they must say the sight word correctly. If the other player does not have a match, they say "go fish" and a card is taken from the pile in the middle. The player with the most matching pairs is the winner.
